



REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. According to Romans 5:8, how does God show His love to us?
(*Jesus died for us while we were still sinners.*)
2. Who was Saul? (*A young man and a Pharisee—an important religious leader of the Jews.*)
3. What are some things kids your age do that go against God?
(*Answers will vary.*)
4. What was Saul doing when he was hurting God's people?
(*He was going against God Himself.*)
5. What happened to Saul when he was going to Damascus?
(*A bright light appeared; Jesus asked Saul why he was persecuting Him.*)
6. Why did Jesus die on the cross? (*To pay the punishment for my sin.*)
7. What happened to Saul after the light disappeared? (*He was blind.*)
8. How can you know God's directions for you? (*They are in the Bible.*)
9. What did Ananias do when God told him to meet Saul? (*He obeyed God.*)
10. What happened when Ananias went to Saul? (*Saul could see; something like scales fell from his eyes.*)
11. What happened on the third day after Jesus died? (*He came back to life; He rose again.*)
12. When does God want you to follow His directions? (*Right away.*)



PRESCHOOL REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. At the beginning of the Bible lesson, how did Saul feel about the Christians?
(*He was angry with them.*)
2. What did Saul see on his way to Damascus? (*A very bright light.*)
3. Who talked to Saul from the bright light? (*God; Jesus.*)
4. What happened to Saul's eyes after he saw the bright light?
(*He couldn't see.*)
5. When Ananias came and prayed for Saul, what happened to his eyes?
(*He could see again.*)
6. Can you name something God made? (*Answers will vary.*)
7. What did God do to show He loves you? (*Sent Jesus to die for me.*)
8. How can you be saved from the punishment of your sin? (*Believe in Jesus as the only one who can save me from sin.*)
9. Say Luke 19:10. (*"For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost."*)
10. Say Romans 5:8. (*"But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners."*)

Review Game "A to Z"

Divide the children into teams. When a child correctly answers a question, his team automatically wins 1,000 points. They can then double their points by guessing the correct letter between A and Z. Have a teacher secretly pick a letter of the alphabet and whisper it to another teacher. Give the child's team ten tries to attempt to guess the correct letter. Involve more children by having a different child guess each time (starting with the child who answered the question, rapidly call on different children to guess.) If they correctly guess the letter, they win double points! If they don't guess the correct letter, the other team gets one chance to guess the correct letter and steal the extra points.

Preschool Review Game "Run to the Goal"

Have the children line up along a starting line. Each child who answers a review question may run to a goal and back while the others cheer. If possible, continue playing until every child has had a turn.
