



## REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. Where did God tell Philip to travel? (*A deserted place, Gaza.*)
2. If you have believed on Jesus as your Savior, what does God want you to be ready to do? (*Tell others about Jesus.*)
3. Why was the Ethiopian traveling to Jerusalem? (*To worship; to learn more about God.*)
4. What separates you from God? (*Sin.*)
5. What did the Ethiopian receive at the temple? (*A scroll; part of the book of Isaiah.*)
6. Why did God bring Philip and the Ethiopian together in the desert? (*He wanted the Ethiopian to learn the truth about who God is.*)
7. How did God show His love for you? (*He sent His Son; answers will vary.*)
8. Who was the scroll talking about? (*Jesus.*)
9. What did Jesus do for you? (*Died on the cross to pay the punishment for my sins.*)
10. What did the Ethiopian do after Philip explained the Scripture? (*He believed; he was baptized.*)
11. What happened to Philip after he baptized the Ethiopian? (*The Holy Spirit took him to another place to teach more people about Jesus.*)
12. What is one way you can tell someone about Jesus? (*Tell him Romans 5:8; answers will vary.*)



## PRESCHOOL REVIEW QUESTIONS

1. Who was telling the people about Jesus? (*Philip.*)
2. What was the Ethiopian reading in his chariot? (*A scroll—the Bible.*)
3. Who sent Philip to the Ethiopian? (*God.*)
4. The Ethiopian was reading a scroll—the Bible. Who was it talking about? (*Jesus.*)
5. Why did Jesus die on the cross? (*For your sins and mine; because He loves you and me.*)
6. What happened to Jesus after He died? (*He came alive again.*)
7. What can you tell someone about Jesus? (*Answers will vary.*)
8. What separates you from God? (*Sin.*)
9. What did Jesus do on the cross? (*He died for our sin.*)
10. How can Jesus take away your sin and give you forever life? (*If I trust Jesus and believe that Jesus died for my sins and came alive again, I can be saved.*)

### Review Game "Hoop It Up"

When a child answers a question correctly, award points to his team then let him try to throw a brightly colored basketball (or any ball available) through a hula hoop for more points. Hold the hoop horizontally or vertically or hold up two misaligned hoops!

### Preschool Review Game "Hoop It Up Junior"

Play as described but do not break into teams. If possible, continue playing until every child has had a turn.
